3rd arrival: 07.08.2018 - 17.08.2018

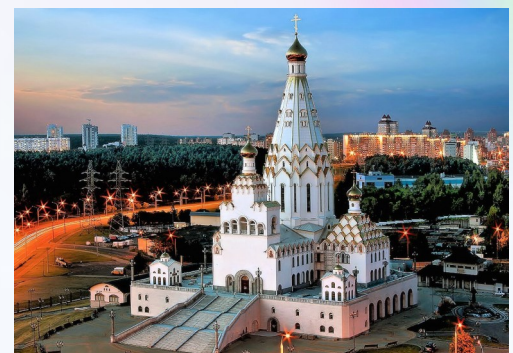
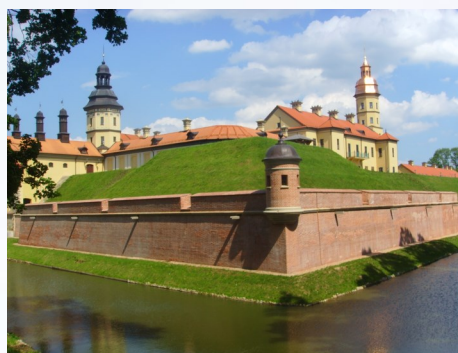
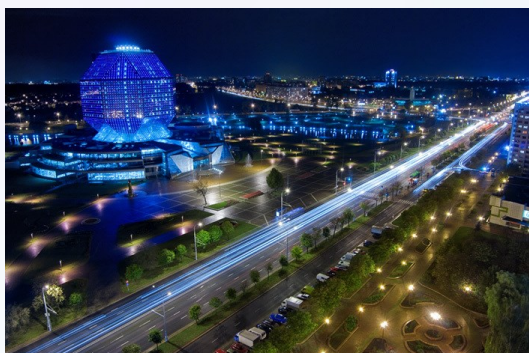
Deadline for submitting documents: 20.07.2018

Classes are held every day except weekends.

Excursions and entertaining programmes will be held every day.

Duration of the programme - **11 days.**

Cost of participation in the programme - **\$200.**



The cost of the programme includes:

- expenses of the organizer for preparation and implementation of the programme;
- meeting of participants at the airport (the railway station);
- transfer to the place of accommodation;
- transfer to the venues;
- issuing invitations (visa letters) to foreign nationals to ensure the receipt of visas (if necessary);
- lodging expenses.

Expenses on participation in the programme:

- visa fee (if a country of residence of a foreign national has a visa regime with Belarus);
- health insurance to obtain a Belarusian visa;
- travelling, board expenses.

Accommodation of participants: comfortable BSUIR dormitories. Each room has a shower, toilet, refrigerator, free Wi-Fi and a kitchen unit.

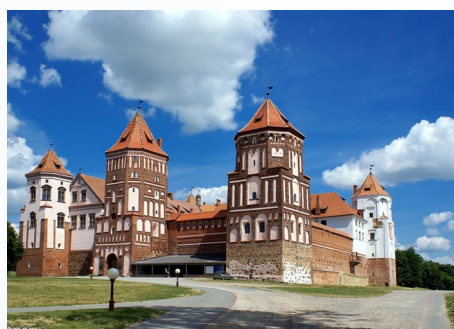
